MISSION:

Our mission is to be a vehicle for respecting and sharing the legacy of Black Wall Street, the Greenwood community of Tulsa, and their descendants through education, arts, commerce, and worldwide engagement. We do this from our base in the Original Black Wall Street where we preserve and protect the buildings on the 100 block of N. Greenwood Avenue to assure their long-term survival, community welfare, a sustainable environment, and continued use. Our mission was strengthened in 2021 when these buildings were officially placed on the National Registry of Historic Buildings and we opened a Women's Business Center. Going forward we are focusing on using our assets to help our community in North Tulsa and beyond.

OUR WORK:

As a Chamber of Commerce our specific goal is to support the small businesses in our community and this can only be achieved if business owners have financial planning, understand savings and are able to build some security. To this end our current programs are: 1) SBA Greenwood Women's Business Center which enables and empowers women entrepreneurs through advocacy, outreach, education, and support. The center provides training, counseling, technical assistance, access to credit and capital, as well as marketing opportunities to women; 2) Housing Program - revitalizing urban Tulsa by rehabilitating historic homes, re-inhabiting vacant land, and increasing community investment by homeownership; 3) Black Wall Street Brunch Club - Idea Creation, Networking, Technology, Wealth and Legacy Building Sessions and; 4) Summer Internship Program for 12 High School seniors to intern with Black Wall Street Business every summer learning what it takes to be an entrepreneur.

OUR STRENGTHS:

Our long-established strengths are our small business expertise, role in the North Tulsa communities, accessibility, and being the site of 44 small minority-owned businesses. New leadership in 2018 brought greater stability and enhanced visibility. We are active in the community and have a sustainable model of rental property that covers basic costs. We engage the community through small business support, youth programs and internships, and shared resources in a state-wide coalition of historic Black townships. With well-established relations with local businesses and community organizations, we support local events, parades, and community activities and are recognized as championing local small businesses led by African-American and other minority businessmen/women. Developing a robust support system that promotes financial health for individuals draws on existing expertise. Organizing, leading, and hosting workshops on financial resiliency is central to our history and mandate.

GOALS

Our objective is to raise enough money to cover our preservation and stadium taxes, keep the HVAC conditioning systems maintained, renovate the restrooms, resurface our parking lot, provide direct grants to the merchants on Greenwood Avenue and ensure long-term operating stability for the Greenwood District.
